## Backpack

- 24 Ticonderoga #2 pencils-  
**SHARPENED PLEASE!**
- 1 pair of child Fiskar scissors
- 2 pink pearl erasers
- 1 hard sided presentation 3-ring binder-1 1/2"
- Non-permanent colored markers
- Colored pencils
- Pencil box
- Crayons
- 12 glue sticks-Scotch Permanent by 3M \* more will be needed later
- 1 bottle of white glue
- 1 pack Expo Dry Erase markers (odorless)
- 2 boxes of crackers or cereal for snack time
- 2 boxes of tissue (for cold season)

## Optional, but appreciated:

- Disposable Camera
- 5 1/2 x 11" white lunch sacks
- Gallon, quart, sandwich sized Ziploc bags
- Pump bottle of hand sanitizer
- Container of disinfecting wipes (Lysol)

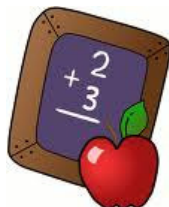


## 2nd Grade

- 5 dozen pencils (do not send these all at once)
- 1 pair quality scissors
- 1 small bottle of Elmer's glue
- 5 glue sticks (do not send all at once)
- 1 box of crayons (any size)
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 box of markers
- 3 highlighters
- 1 box of tissues (to share with class)
- 4 red colored pencils (send one or 2 at a time)
- 2 large pink pearl erasers
- Ruler with centimeters and inches
- Pencil pouch or box large enough to store goodies
- Notebook paper (wide ruled, to be shared with the class)
- 2 Peechees or folders
- 1 spiral notebook

- 1 box of sandwich sized Ziploc bags
- 1 box of quart sized Ziploc bags
- 1 box of gallon sized Ziploc bags
- pencils

- Red or purple correcting pens
- 2 pink pearl erasers
- Hand-held sharpener (with a shavings catcher)
- 4 Expo (dry erase) markers
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 4 dozen no. 2 pencils (sharpened if possible)
- 1 spiral notebook
- 1 package of reward stickers (positive comments)
- 1 package of 5 tab dividers
- Bottle of hand sanitizer or pack of disinfectant wipes
- 1 package of wide ruled notebook paper or a box of band-aids
- fine tipped blue and black Sharpie marker (for map labeling)

## 4<sup>th</sup> Grade

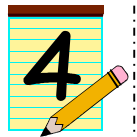
### Individual Supplies
