Arrival at Hanford High – Teams should NOT arrive prior to 1:30 Enter into the gym foyer and go to the small Eryie gym. The wrestling room will be available. No one should be in the halls. Please cooperate with school administration and security for the ending of our school day by staying in the gym area.

Weigh-In Procedures- All wrestlers will weigh-in on both days of the tournament, regardless if they are scheduled to wrestle or not. Weigh-ins will take place in the small Eryie Gym.

Seeding – Coaches need to log on to the following website and enter their wrestlers by Tuesday January 31. <http://www.jcrawford.net/wrestlers.html> Seeding will take place at Hanford on Friday Feb. 3 at 10AM in the hospitality room

Locker rooms – Locker rooms will be available for the teams in the tournament. The locker rooms will not be locked or supervised. Towels will not be provided. Do not leave valuables in the locker room.

Hospitality Room – Will be provided for coaches, officials, tournament works and administrators. It will be located in the class room in the back of the Falcon gym.

Trainer – Hanford High School trainer, Jody Treadway and her students will be working the tournament. They will provide ice for injury, water and basic treatment as needed. Please supply your own supplies if taping is needed.

Passes – The administration from each school will provide a pass list to Hanford High School prior to the tournament. The # of passes will follow District 5 guidelines.

Passes - Each wrestler will be on a pass list
Up to 5 coaches (wrist bands will be provided)
Up to 5 supervisors (principal, athletic director, etc)
Up to 4 support personnel (manager, trainer, stats)
Cheerleaders in uniform and Coach

Admission Prices –

Format- Each weight class is a double elimination, 16 man bracket. Every wrestler will have two matches on Friday night. The top 5 wrestlers advance to the regionals. #6 will have a pigtail with the #3 from the GSL to gain entry into the tournament the following weekend.

Awards – A team plaque will be awarded to the 1st place team. Medals will be awarded to the weight class champions and ribbons will be awarded to individuals finishing in places 2-6.

Scoring – Each person in the tournament scores points for their team as they advance in the tournament. Automatic points equal to a pin are awarded whenever 2 wrestlers from the same school meet.
