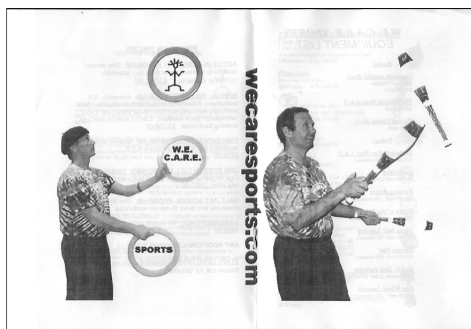

Size: Artwork must be drawn horizontally or vertically on a letter sized (8 1/2" x 11") page. Due to printing requirements, no 3-D or collages will be accepted. All artwork must be original. Artwork not meeting these specifications will be ineligible for the contest.

Materials: Plain white paper, white board, construction board, or art board may be used as long as size requirements are met. Please use crayons, felt pens, acrylics, pastels, watercolors, poster paints, or grease pencils. **Please use no more than 4 colors.**

Release: A completed, signed release form must be firmly taped to the back of each artwork entry. Artwork submitted to the contest becomes the property of the Humane Society of Central Washington and may not be returned to the artist.

Judging: The winner will be selected by the Board of Directors and notified by April 10th, 2012.

Prize: The winning entry will receive two t-shirts portraying his/her artwork, a \$25 cash prize, and recognition in the Humane Society of Central Washington's newsletter. The artwork of the winning entrant and honorable mention nominees will be displayed prominently in the shelter before and during the event.

West Valley School District Kindergarten Registration Instructions 2012 – 2013 school year

Welcome to West Valley schools! We hope that this will be the beginning of many happy years of learning for your child. In order to register your child for kindergarten, you will need to provide the following documents and forms: [Registrations will be accepted starting March 26th, 2012.](#)

PROOF OF ADDRESS: To verify that your child resides within our attendance boundaries, you will need to provide proof of your current address (a utility bill or phone bill is the preferred documentation, rental/purchase agreements acceptable and driver license can be given until one of the other forms of verification is available).

BIRTH CERTIFICATE: To be eligible for kindergarten, your child must turn five by August 31st, 2012. To verify age, we will need your child's official health district birth certificate (we will make a copy for our file). We can not accept the birth certificate from the hospital.

IMMUNIZATIONS: Please obtain a copy of your child's immunization information from your health care provider to complete the Certificate of Immunization for. The following immunizations are required and must be documented before your child's first day of school. Please complete the Certificate of Immunization Status form (CIS) and sign and date in the upper right hand corner of the CIS form.

5 DPT, with last dose administered on or after the age of 4. (4- **if** dose 4 given on or after 4th birthday)

4 Polio, **if** last dose administered on or after the age of 4. (3- **if** dose 3 given on or after 4th birthday)

2 MMR, 1st dose must be on or after 1st birthday. 2nd dose must be at least 28 days after 1st dose.

3 Hepatitis B

2 Varicella (chickenpox), 1st dose must be on or after 1st birthday. If child has had the chickenpox, we need health care provider documentation.

CUMULATIVE RECORD (blue): This form will follow your child throughout his or her school career. Please fill out the top portion only (above solid line).

ENROLLMENT FORM (yellow): Please complete entire enrollment form. Make sure you include names of individuals other than the parent/guardian who can be contacted in the event of an emergency (Emergency 1 and 2).

HEALTH RECORD (tan): Please fill in the child's name, birth date, and school.

HEALTH HISTORY (green): Please complete both sides. Please mark N/A if it is not applicable.

PRESCHOOL/CHILDCARE RECORDS: If your child attended preschool or childcare, please complete and sign the enclosed form.
