Holidays

The district will observe the following school holidays and shall not operate on these days:

- 1. Sunday;
- 2. New Years' Day (January 1,);
- 3. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (third Monday in January);
- 4. President's Day (third Monday in February);
- 5. Memorial Day (last Monday in May);
- 6. Juneteenth (June 19);
- 7. Independence Day (July 4);
- 8. Labor Day (first Monday in September);
- 9. Veteran's Day (November 11);
- 10. Thanksgiving Day (fourth Thursday in November);
- 11. The day after Thanksgiving; and
- 12. Christmas Day (December 25).

Whenever any legal holiday, other than Sunday, falls on a Sunday, the following Monday will be a legal holiday, and whenever any legal holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday will be a legal holiday.

In addition to the above, the following shall also be considered to be holidays: the day before Christmas and the day before New Year's Day (December 24 and December 31).
