

3245P - Students and Telecommunication/Electronic Devices

Recording in the classroom and educational settings

Classrooms and other educational settings are non-public forums. Students must have pre-approval from the teacher to record any portion of a lesson. If a student records in the classroom or educational setting without pre-approval from the teacher, the student will be subject to disciplinary action.

Recording of student fights

The District has determined that recording of student fights by students is disruptive to the educational environment and may contribute/incite additional disruption. Students who record student fights will be subject to disciplinary action. Prohibition of recording of student fights shall apply:

- On school District property at any time;
- Off school District property at any school activity, function, or event;
- On school buses or vehicles provided by the District;
- Off school District property if the actions of the student materially or substantially effect the education process and/or student attendance at school.
