Strategic Plan Evaluation

In preparing its report to the Board of Directors, the Superintendent and the strategic planning engages in the following process:

- 1. Review the environmental scanning data collected since the last annual evaluation.
- 2. Review the action plans to assess to what degree they have been implemented successfully; and analyze the reasons for success or failure in implementation.
- 3. Review the belief statements, mission statement, objectives and strategies of the district's strategic plan for a fundamental evaluation of the district's progress and direction.
- 4. Draft recommendations to the Board to proceed, modify, realign or end specific activities undertaken to implement the strategic plan. Identify budget implications flowing from those recommendations. Draft recommended changes in the strategic plan, if any.

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
