Student Health

The Superintendent will arrange for health services for all students. Such services will include but are not limited to:

- A. The maintenance of student health records;
- B. The development of procedures at each building for the isolation and temporary care of students who become ill during the school day;
- C. Consulting services of a licensed healthcare provider and/or Registered Nurse;
- D. Vision (both distance and near) and hearing screening; and
- E. Immunization records and screening.

In accordance with District Policy 3410, the Board grants school principals the authority to send an ill child home with parent notification, without the concurrence of the local health officer, but if the disease is reportable, the local health officer must be notified.
