The district supports limitations on the availability of foods and beverages of minimal nutritional value. The district supports the philosophy of the National School Lunch and Breakfast programs and recognizes it as the primary meal program within the district.

The district recognizes that the availability of non-nutritious foods undermines nutrition education efforts, encourages over-consumption of foods high in fat and added sugar.

It is the intent of the district to limit the availability of foods of minimal nutritional value within the district.
